Mayor Pro-Tem Young declared the meeting open at 6:00 pm.

Roll Call: Alderman Cole Alexander; here, Alderman David Keating; here, Alderman David Young; here, Alderman Brenda Jaco; here, City Clerk Lexie May; here.

Guests present: Ron Hirst, Dana Sewell, Sean Main, Valarie Sponcler, and Kyndel Smith.

Mayor Pro-Tem Young requested a motion to approve the agenda. Alderman Alexander made a motion to approve agenda. Alderman Jaco second, all in favor, motion passed.

Mayor Pro-Tem Young requested a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting. Alderman Keating made a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting, Alderman Alexander second, all in favor, motion passed.

Mayor Pro-Tem Young requested a motion to approve monthly bills. Alderman Keating made the motion to approve the monthly bills, Alderman Alexander second all in favor, motion passed.

Mayor's Comments: Mayor Pro-Tem Young informed the board of a water leak that was found on Sunday May 29th. He informed the Board that Matt Helmig, Matt Castle, and Michael came and fixed the leak on Monday. Three houses were put under a boil advisory and were notified. He also informed the board that he had told Michael and Lexie about keeping a maintenance log to keep the Board informed on what maintenance is being done.

Special Guests

Kyndel Smith attended the meeting to get approval to put in a mobile home at 409 N Washington. Alderman Cole made a motion to approve this mobile home as long as the ordinances are followed, Alderman Jaco second, all in favor, motion passed.

There was no representative present for the Street Fair but the Board was provided a packet. The packet included streets to be closed and request for a liquor license. Alderman Alexander made a motion to approve the street closures presented and approve the liquor license, Alderman Keating second, all in favor, motion passed.

Old Business: Discussion was held regarding a vehicle tracker. Alderman Keating made a motion to purchase the Vyncs tracker, Alderman Alexander second, all in favor, motion passed.

The Board was informed that the Columbia Landfill will accept the sludge from the lagoon but the City will be responsible for hauling it.

Alderman Keating made a motion for Lexie and Brenda to find out dates that would be available for a city clean-up and pick one that works best for Brenda because she will be in charge of it, Alderman Alexander second, all in favor, motion passed.

Discussion was held regarding the DNR improvement plan. Alderman Keating made a motion for Mid-Mo Operators to make a plan and put it in writing and then hold a special meeting to get it approved before it is sent, Alderman Alexander second, all in favor, motion passed.

Discussion was held regarding the letter from Dana Sewell. Alderman Keating made a motion to table selling the property until a later date and in the meantime the City will work on keeping that area cleaned up, Alderman Alexander second, all in favor, motion passed.

Discussion was held regarding the culvert behind the Methodist Church alleyway. Alderman Alexander informed the board that the end of the culvert is bent but the rest looks fine. Discussion was also held regarding an area north of the alleyway that has washed out next to Preston Seifert's house. Alderman Keating made a motion to repair the bent culvert and to table the culvert north of the alleyway until next meeting after getting some estimates for repair, Alderman Alexander second, all in favor, motion passed.

Mayor Pro-Tem Young called for a motion to appoint a Mayor. Alderman Young made a motion to appoint Sean Main as Mayor. Discussion was held. Alderman Keating made a second to appoint Sean Main as Mayor. Roll Call: Alderman Alexander; no, Alderman Keating; yes, Alderman Young; yes, Alderman Jaco; no. Mayor Pro-Tem broke the tie with a vote to appoint Sean Main as Mayor to finish the term.

Sean Main was sworn in as mayor.

New Business: Mayor Sean Main read the Hazard Mitigation Resolution in title only. Mayor Main requested a motion to pass this resolution. Alderman Young made a motion to pass this resolution, Alderman Alexander second, all in favor, motion passed.

Alderman Keating made a motion to fill out and have Mayor Main sign the form to join the National Flood Insurance Program, Alderman Alexander second, all in favor, motion passed with a 4-0 vote.

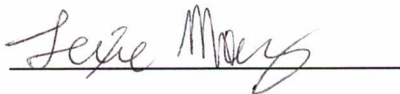
